SNOW EMERGENCIES AND SNOW REMOVAL

A snow emergency may be declared when at least two inches of snow has fallen in a 24-hour period. During this time, there is no parking on City streets until snow has been plowed curb to curb (typically 24 to 48 hours). Any vehicles in violation will be ticketed and towed.
