

A Special Meeting of the Common Council was held on Monday, November 7, 2011 at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers with Mayor Oberle presiding. Council Members present: Tellijohn, Spinler, Kerkow, Wicks, Schultz, Broeder, and Mayor Oberle. Council Members absent: None. City Administrator Rick Almich, Public Works Director Ron Sinell, City Building Official Dan Murphy, and Bolton & Menk Principal Engineers Owen Todd and Bill Douglas were also present.

Bolton and Menk Principal Engineers Owen Todd and Bill Douglas presented a general overview regarding the establishment and operation of a Storm Water Utility Program. It was the consensus of the Council to consider the proposed establishment of said utility program at the November 28, 2011 Regular City Council Meeting.

City Building Official Dan Murphy presented general information regarding the City's option to establish an electrical inspection program for the purpose of enforcing the State of Minnesota Electrical Code within the community.
