

A Regular Meeting of the Common Council was held on Monday, February 9, 2009 at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers with Mayor Oberle presiding. Council Members present: LaBelle, Spinler, Kerkow, Broeder, Vortherms, and Wicks. Council Members absent: None. City Administrator Rick Almich, City Attorney Todd Coryell, Police Chief Bruce Kelly and Mark Osborn were also present.

A motion by Council Member Wicks, seconded by Council Member LaBelle approving the Minutes of the Regular Meeting of January 26, 2009. Voting in favor: Council Members LaBelle, Spinler, Kerkow, Broeder, Vortherms, Wicks, and Mayor Oberle. Voting no: None. Motion carried.

A motion by Council Member Broeder, seconded by Council Member Spinler approving the Minutes of the Special Meeting of February 2, 2009. Voting in favor: Council Members LaBelle, Spinler, Kerkow, Broeder, Vortherms, Wicks, and Mayor Oberle. Voting no: None. Motion carried.

Mayor Oberle opened the Public Hearing to consider and pass upon the conveyance by Quit Claim Deed a parcel of land from the City of Le Sueur to Jamie and Kendra Miller.

City Attorney Todd Coryell explained the reason for the Quit Claim Deed.

Mayor Oberle closed the Public Hearing.

A motion by Council Member Wicks, seconded by Council Member Broeder to Introduce and Waive the First Reading of **Ordinance #514** authorizing the execution of a Quit Claim Deed. Voting in favor: Council Members LaBelle, Spinler, Kerkow, Broeder, Vortherms, Wicks, and Mayor Oberle. Voting no: None. Motion carried.

A motion by Council Member Kerkow, seconded by Council Member Spinler to adopt Resolution #09-008 accepting the bid from Fahrner Asphalt Sealers, LLC in the amount of \$43,993.50 for the Airport Slurry Seal/Crack Fill Project and award the bid contingent upon receiving a Federal Grant and more clearly stated in said Resolution #09-008. Voting in favor: Council Members LaBelle, Spinler, Kerkow, Broeder, Vortherms, Wicks, and Mayor Oberle. Voting no: None. Motion carried.

Mark Osborn approached the Council. He currently owns property in the river bottom area west of the railroad tracks within City limits. He is requesting to be allowed to bow hunt during the designated hunting seasons. Hunting is not allowed within City limits by City Ordinance. Much discussion followed.

A motion by Council Member Kerkow, seconded by Council Member LaBelle to deny Mr. Osborn's request to hunt within City Limits. Voting in favor: Council Members LaBelle, Spinler, Kerkow, Broeder, Vortherms, Wicks, and Mayor Oberle. Voting no: None. Motion carried.

A motion by Council Member Wicks, seconded by Council Member LaBelle to approve the List of Bills of February 9, 2009 as printed. Voting in favor: Council Members LaBelle, Spinler, Kerkow, Broeder, Vortherms, Wicks, and Mayor Oberle. Voting no: None. Motion carried.

A motion by Council Member Kerkow, seconded by Council Member Wicks and duly carried to adjourn.
