

A Regular Meeting of the Common Council was held on Monday, September 28, 2009 at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers with Mayor Oberle presiding. Police Chief Bruce Kelly, Water/Waster Director Brian Skok, City Engineer Owen Todd, Agent of Record Jeff McDonald, Le Sueur Chamber Representatives Dana Manske and Julie Boyland were also present.

A motion by Council Member Wicks, seconded by Council Member LaBelle approving the Minutes of the Regular Meeting of September 14, 2009. Voting in favor: Council Members LaBelle, Spinler, Kerkow, Broeder, Vortherms, Wicks, and Mayor Oberle. Voting no: None. Motion carried.

Dana Manske representing the Chamber of Commerce approached the Council to request closing a portion of Ferry Street between Second and Main Streets and then a portion of South Main for their 1st Annual Fall in the Valley Car Cruise on October 10, 2009.

A motion by Council Member Wicks, seconded by Council Member Kerkow approving the closing of a portion of Ferry Street and Main Streets on October 10, 2009 for the Valley Car Cruise.
