**PURPOSE**

Provide the City Council with an update on the damages and repairs from flooding and storms March 12 thru May 1.

**SUMMARY**

On June 12, 2019, President Trump issued a major disaster declaration that includes the City of Le Sueur. In the initial damage assessment worksheets, the City listed damages to:

- Dobby Lane
  - Rip-rap, 1.5" clear gravel and ¾" gravel have been placed. Material removed from Cambria ditch and ravine.
- Woods Drive
  - Repaired frost boils and wash out with ¾" gravel
- Water Street
  - ¾" gravel placed.
- Mayo Park Picnic Shelter
  - Picnic tables removed. No site repairs yet.
- Mayo Park Picnic Area
  - Mowing areas that can be mowed. No site repairs yet.
- River Park Restrooms
  - Remain closed and portable toilet on site
- River Park Boat Landing
  - Cleaned out landing.
- Compost Site
  - ¾" gravel placed
  - Moved to Boright currently

Staff has not met with a FEMA/HSEM Project Manager as of yet. We are waiting to be contacted to set up the meeting. Following the meeting, staff will get approval for the remaining repairs before proceeding. Staff will also be asking to apply for Hazard Mitigation Grants for damaged areas.
