
CSAH 22 (TH112) Construction

The City of Le Sueur and Le Sueur County approved the start of construction by awarding the project to low bidder S.M. Hentges & Sons, Inc. from Jordan, MN. The construction of County State Aid Highway (CSAH) 22 (formerly know as Highway 112) is planned to **tentatively start in May and will consist of two summers of construction, ending in fall of 2021.**

The project will be completed in a series of phases throughout the two years and will be focused entirely within City limits. We encourage residents to visit the project website for additional information and to sign up for email construction updates at www.thenew22construction.com.

Residents who live directly along the project will receive additional information via direct mailings prior to the project start date. **A neighborhood construction meeting is coming soon and tentatively planned for mid-April.**
