



2020 Aqua Valley Outdoor Pool Rules

- Street shoes on the deck are prohibited.
- Hanging on the lane line or using the lane line for support is prohibited.
- All persons are required to take a shower before entering the pool area.
- Personal conduct within the pool facility must be such that the safety of self and others is not jeopardized. No running/boisterous/rough play.
- Goggles that cover the nose or mouth are prohibited.
- Snorkels are prohibited.
- Only clean swimsuit apparel is allowed in the pool.
- No food or beverages other than water allowed on the pool deck.
- No containers made of glass of any kind allowed on the pool deck.
- For the safety of our patrons, children must be at least 7 years old to be admitted into the main pool without an adult.
- Everyone who enters the pool is required to pay and wear a wristband.
- All flotation devices must be coast guard approved - this includes regulated life jackets and puddle jumpers. The following flotation devices that are not allowed include but are not limited to: beach balls, inflatable arm floaties, and inner tubes.
- Diving in any area outside the diving well is not permitted.
- All children who are not toilet trained must wear a swim diaper.
- Spitting, spouting water, blowing the nose, or otherwise introducing contaminants into the pool is not permitted.
- A person under the influence of alcohol or exhibiting erratic behavior shall not be permitted in the pool area.
- Any participants that use a lifejacket are not permitted in the deep end.
- Admission to the pool shall be refused to all persons having contagious diseases or infection conditions such as: colds, fever, ringworm, foot infections, skins lesions, diarrhea, vomiting, inflamed eyes, ear discharge, or any other condition which has the appearance of being infections. Persons with excessive sunburn, abrasions which have not healed, adhesive tape, rubber bandages, and other bandages of any kind, also shall be refused admittance.
- All Community Center staff has the right to implement additional rules for the protection of the guests and safety of the facility.
- Diving board is to be used for forward facing dives.
- Patrons must ride down the slide feet first.

Additional Rules Due to COVID-19

- Pool toys such as balls and water guns are prohibited.
- No tables or chairs will be available to the public on the deck – you are welcome to bring your own chairs.
- No equipment will be made available during lap swim or water walking, if patrons wish they can bring their own noodles, kick boards, pull buoys, and swim belts.
- Unless you are with a member of your family, all patrons must maintain a distance of six (6) feet at all times.
- We discourage any changing in the locker rooms area - locker rooms are only to be used for restroom purposes.
- No horseplay of any kind.
- No spitting or blowing water.
- We encourage patrons to reserve a swimming timeslot online ahead of time, walk-ins will only be accepted if there is room available in the given timeslot.
- Each patron must complete a COVID-19 waiver each day they attend the pool.
