WHO CAN BRING THEIR MATERIALS TO THE SITE?

Residents who live in the City limits of Le Sueur. All residents should be prepared to show their driver's license or an alternate form of identification if needed. No waste from non-residential customers, contractors, businesses or those residing outside of the City limits will be accepted. Waste Management has the right to determine the final acceptability of waste items.

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

- General non-hazardous household waste "junk"
- Furniture items
 - Couches/chairs/tables/mattresses/box springs/etc.
- Small amounts of remodeling materials
 - Siding/dried-out paint cans/drywall/carpet/etc.

PREPARATION GUIDELINES:

- All items **must be** boxed, bagged or contained and/or easily transferable into garbage receptacles

WE CANNOT ACCEPT:

- Asbestos
- Batteries
- Chemical/cleaning products
- Fluorescent tubes/light bulbs
- Hazardous/infectious waste
- Industrial waste
- Liquid waste
- Paints, thinners, removers
- Oils, oil rags
- Radioactive materials
- Shingles
- Tires
- Yard waste

A fee will be charged for some electronics and appliances.
