## Construction Season is Starting Soon! CSAH 36 (South Main Street/Ferry Street Reconstruction)

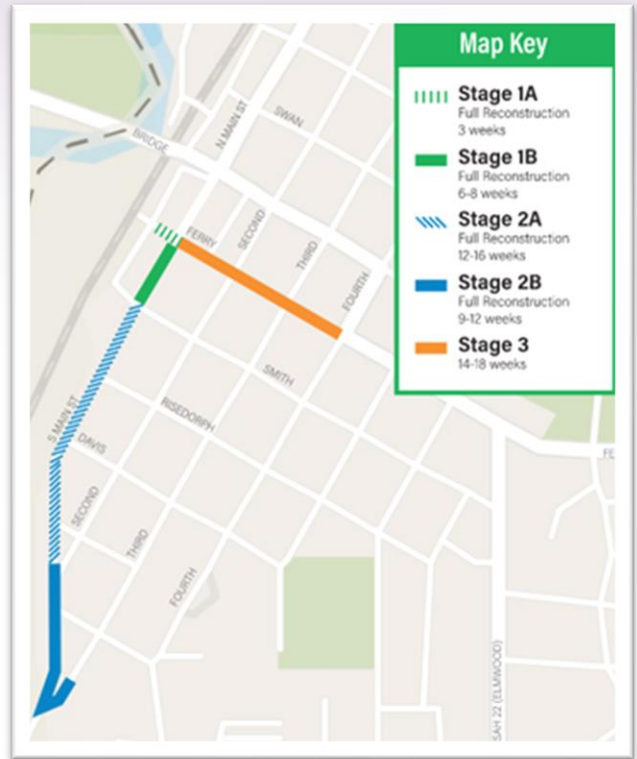
The City of Le Sueur and Le Sueur County approved the start of construction by awarding the project to low bidder S.M. Hentges & Sons, Inc. from Jordan, MN. S.M. Hentges is the same contractor that completed the CSAH 22 (TH 112) project under construction the past two summers. The construction of County State Aid Highway (CSAH) 36 is planned to start on May 2<sup>nd</sup> and will consist of one summer of major construction, with the final wear course and cleanup ending in early summer 2023.

The project will be completed in a series of stages throughout the summer and the contractor is required to start initially with Stage 1A and 1B. We encourage residents to visit the project website for additional information and to sign up for weekly email construction updates at:

- Small amounts of remodeling materials
  - Siding/dried-out paint cans/drywall/carpet/etc.

- All items must be boxed, bagged, or contained and/or easily transferable into garbage receptacles.
