We are still finalizing details, so please check our website and social media pages for additional information.

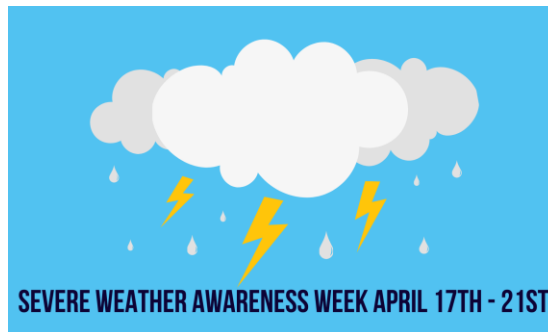


Severe Weather Awareness Week

Families, Schools, and Businesses Should Participate in Tornado Drills on April 20th

Are you ready for severe weather? Each year the Homeland Security and Emergency Management department, along with the National Weather Service sponsor **Severe Weather Awareness week in Minnesota**. Activities are designed to refresh, remind, and educate everyone about the seasonal threats from severe weather and how to avoid them. There is no pattern to where or when severe weather will occur.

Severe Weather Awareness Week takes place April 17th – 21st, with statewide tornado drills on **Thursday, April 20th at 1:45pm and 6:45pm**. The National Weather Service will issue a simulated tornado warning and outdoor warning sirens will be activated.

Residents who live in Le Sueur City limits. Proof of residency required. No waste from non-residential customers, contractors, businesses, or those residing outside of the City limits will be accepted.

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

- General non-hazardous household waste "junk"
- Furniture
 - Couches/chairs/tables/mattresses/box springs/etc.
- Small amounts of remodeling materials
 - Siding/dried-out paint cans/drywall/carpet/etc.

PREPARATION GUIDELINES:

- All items must be boxed, bagged, or contained and/or easily transferable into garbage receptacles.

A fee will be charged for some electronics and appliances.
