Do you use an external video security system or a doorbell camera at your home or business? If so, please consider registering your camera(s) with the Le Sueur Police Department.

This is a voluntary police/community partnership with homeowners, renters, and business owners intended to let our officers know where cameras are active in the city in the event a crime occurs nearby. This program will not be used for active police surveillance and officers **will not** have direct access to any cameras. If a crime occurs nearby, your camera system may have captured information that could be critical in solving a crime.

Those who register may be contacted and asked if they are willing to assist if a crime occurs in the vicinity of the camera. Information provided by residents and businesses will be maintained in a secure database.
